Pope Benedict XVI appointed four 4 Bishops from the United States to participate in the World Synod of Bishops from 5-26 October 2009 to explore the theme "The Word of God in the Life and Mission of the Church." The Pope appointed:

- Cardinal Francis George of Chicago, president of the U.S. Episcopal conference;
- Bishop Gerald Kicanas of Tucson, Arizona, vice president of the conference;
- Cardinal Daniel DiNardo of Houston, Texas; and
- Archbishop Donald Wuerl of Washington, D.C.
